## Creek to Coral Drawing Contest

## OFFICIAL RULES

**1. HOW TO ENTER**: The Creek to Coral Drawing Contest ("Drawing Contest") is a recurring series of biannual drawing contests, held twice per year. Entry periods are running from:

**When:** Drawing contests take place twice a year- once during fall and once during spring. The deadlines are:

SUMMER\_AUTUMN: 24 September-**21 March (deadline for entries)** and WINTER-SPRING: 22 March- **23 September (deadline for entries)** 

Entries can be sent either by mail or by email. Entrants must specify their name, age, and contact details including email, telephone, and postal address.

IMPORTANT: If the entrant is under 18 years of age He/she must make sure that He/she has permission from parents of legal guardian to enter the contest.

All entries become the property of Creek to Coral and cannot be returned. Creek to Coral assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected, illegible or mutilated entries.

- **2. ELIGIBILITY**: This Drawing Contest is open to any person residing in Townsville or Thuringowa. Persons from 7 to 77 years of age are eligible to participate. They will be entering different categories according to their date of birth as follows:
- 7-12 years old: "Kitten" Category
- 13-18 years old: "Junior" Category
- 19-77 years old: "Senior" Category

This Drawing Contest is governed by the laws of Australia and is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

- **3. JUDGING**: One (1) biannual winner will be selected, based on merit, by Creek to Coral staff within one month of the closing date of each seasonal contest, from all eligible entries received. All prizes will be awarded if applicable. Limit one prize per person, family or household. Winners will be notified via email, Australia mail, fax or telephone.
- **4. PRIZES**: The one (1) winner selected each season (every six months) will have one (1) prize granted if applicable. Each winning entry will be featured on the Creek to Coral website and in the Creek to Coral newsletter. Winners will be credited by legal name and suburb of residence.

Winners will receive a Certificate of Recognition and one (1) copy of the Creek to Coral newsletter featuring their entries.

**5. GENERAL CONDITIONS:** Winners grant Creek to Coral the right to use and publish their Drawing, legal name and suburb of residence online and in print, or any other media, in connection with the Drawing Contest.
